Notes:

- National legislation prohibiting cluster munitions in **Austria** and **Belgium** requires the destruction of stockpiles.
- **Argentina** and **Honduras** have indicated to the Cluster Munition Coalition that they destroyed their stockpiles.
- **Canada** is in the process of destroying its stockpile of cluster munitions.
- **Montenegro** and **Uganda** announced their intent to destroy their stockpiles at the Belgrade Conference of Countries Affected by Cluster Munition in October 2007.
- The **Czech Republic**, **France**, **Germany**, **Netherlands**, **Norway**, **Poland**, **Portugal**, **Switzerland**, and **United Kingdom** have destroyed certain types of cluster munitions.
