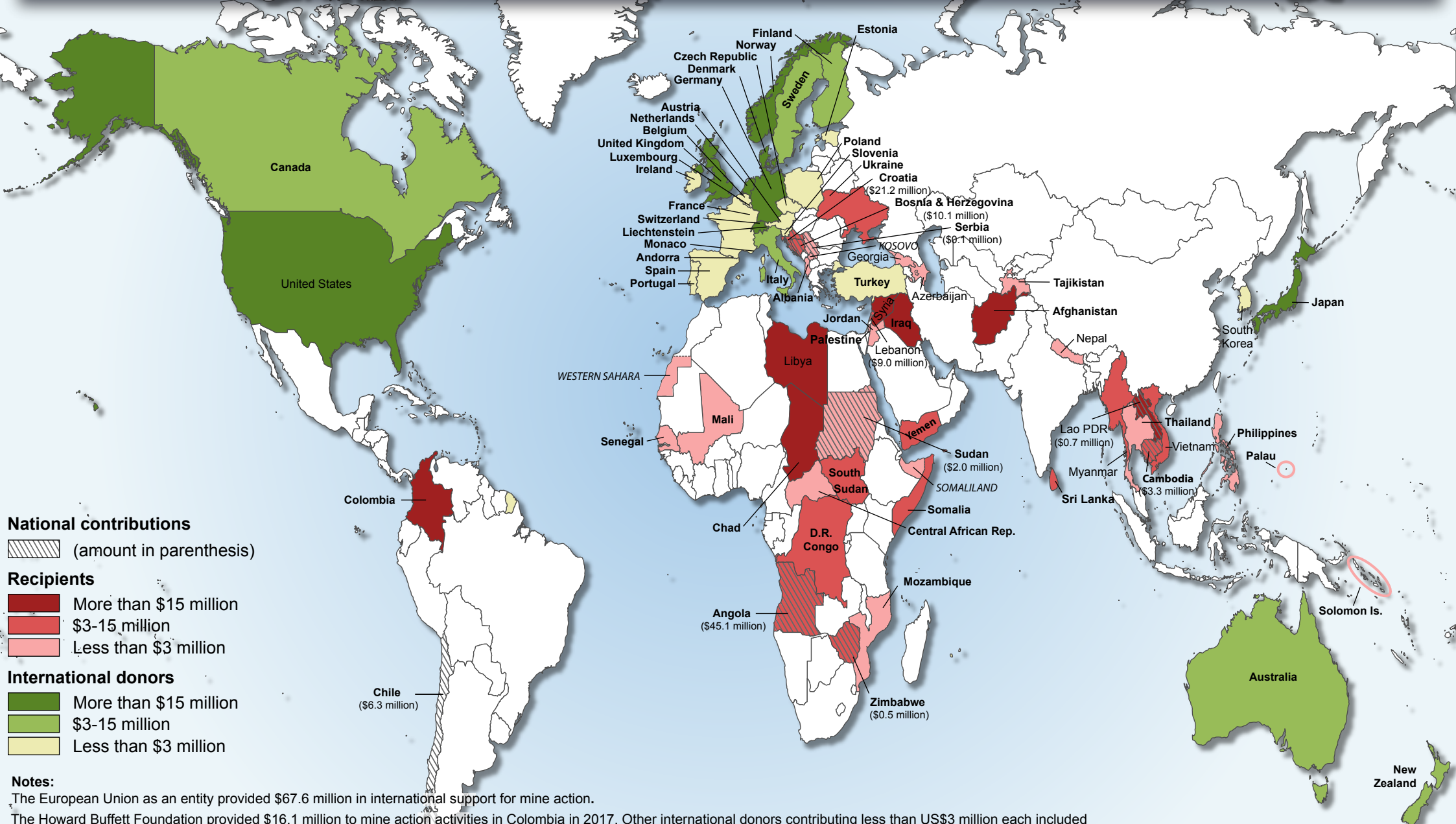


Support for Mine Action: 2017

 The Howard Buffett Foundation provided \$16.1 million to mine action activities in Colombia in 2017. Other international donors contributing less than US\$3 million each included the Office of Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs, the OPEC Fund for International Development, Sudan Humanitarian Fund, UNA-Sweden, and the United Nations.
