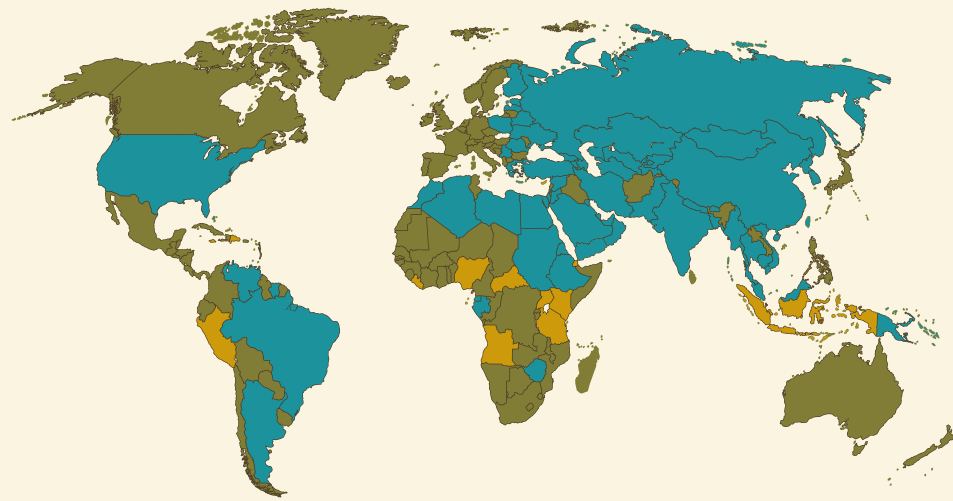

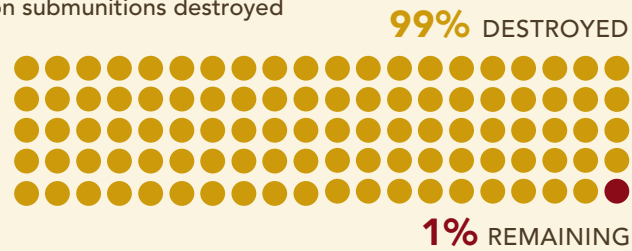
STATUS OF THE CONVENTION* ON CLUSTER MUNITIONS

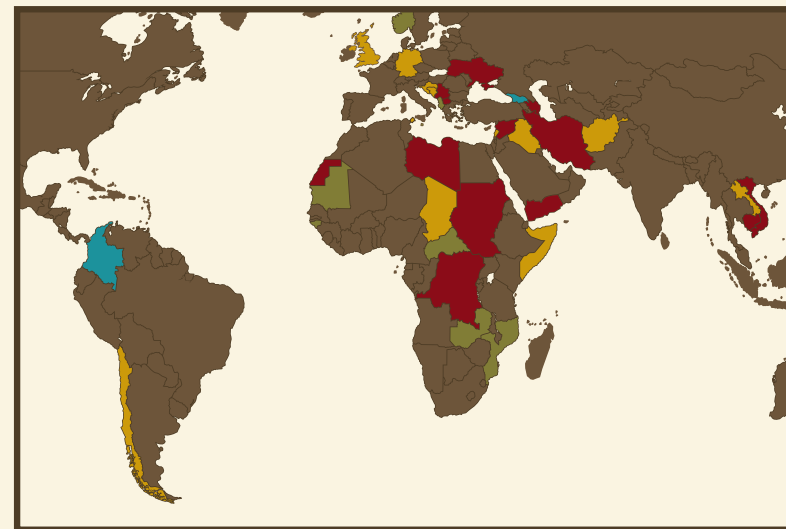

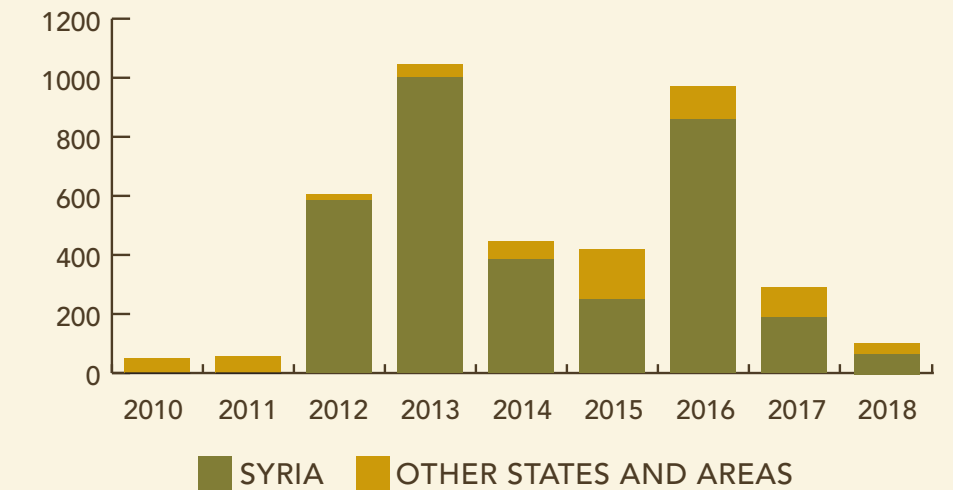

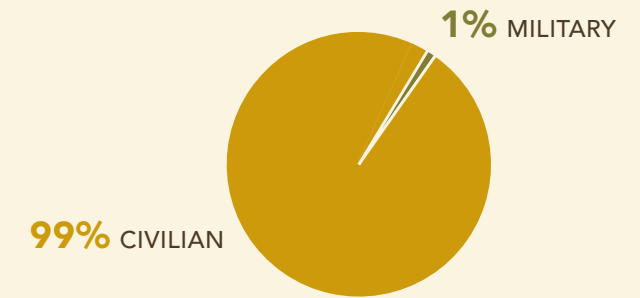


Cluster munition casualties in: 14 States Parties, 4 signatories, 16 non-signatories, and three other areas.

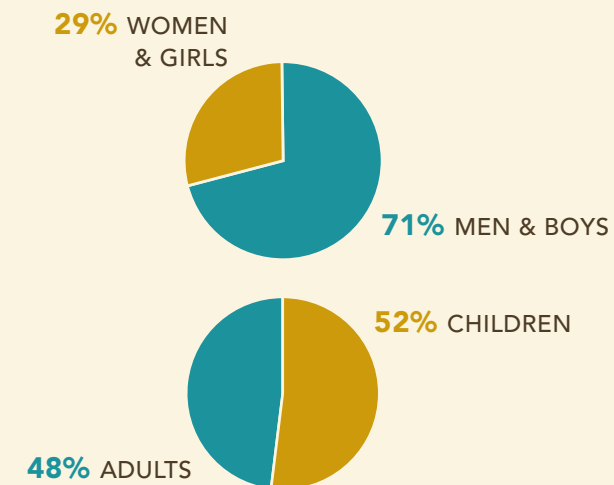
CLUSTER MUNITION CASUALTIES IN SYRIA AND OTHER COUNTRIES AND AREAS 2010-2018

Cluster munition victims include survivors (people who were injured by cluster munitions or their explosive remnants and lived), other persons directly impacted by cluster munitions, as well as their affected families and communities. As a result of their injuries, most cluster munition survivors are also persons with disabilities.
