








CLUSTER MUNITION CLEARANCE IN 2018-2019

TOTAL CLUSTER MUNITION CASUALTIES: 286
77% of casualties were caused by cluster munition attacks in 2019.

In 2019, cluster munitions casualties were recorded in: Afghanistan, Iraq, Lao PDR, Lebanon, Libya, Serbia, South Sudan, Syria, Yemen, as well as Nagorno-Karabakh and Western Sahara.
