



### **TOTAL CLUSTER MUNITION CASUALTIES: 360**


60% of casualties were caused by cluster munition remnants in 2020


**BOYS AND MEN** BY SURVIVAL OUTCOME

IN 2019-2020 (as reported by States Parties)




