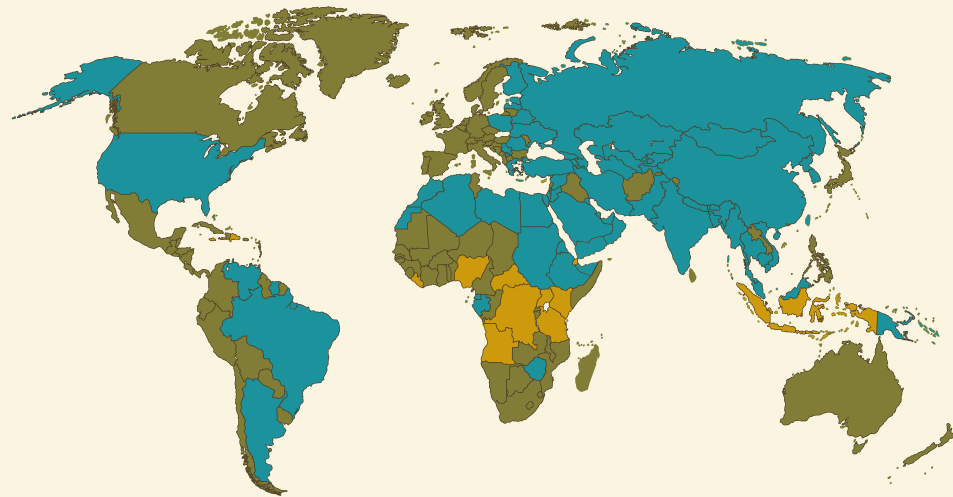

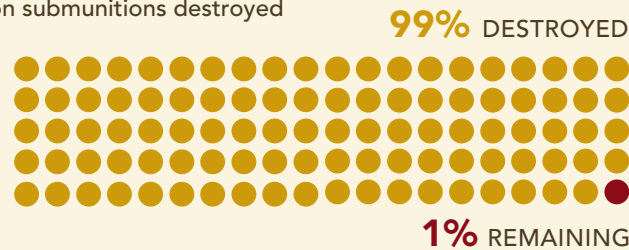
### STATUS OF THE CONVENTION ON CLUSTER MUNITIONS\*

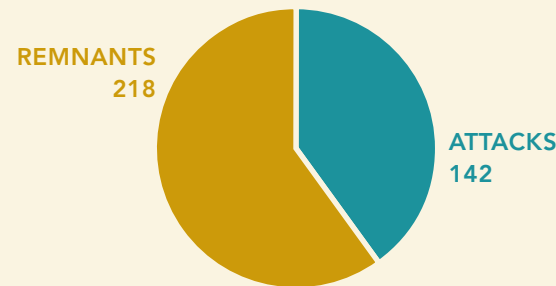

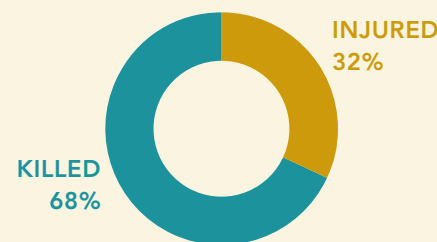


Number of countries and other areas where cluster munition casualties have been recorded in 2020

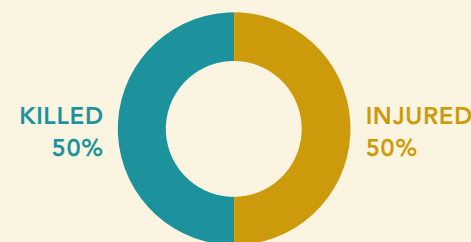


**TOTAL CLUSTER MUNITION CASUALTIES: 360**
